AWARD FOR DISTINGUISHED SERVICE TO CALIFORNIA GIRLS AND WOMEN IN SPORT

Criteria:

1. Candidates shall have served professionally in school, college or community programs for a period of at least ten years prior to nomination.
2. Candidates shall be persons of high personal integrity who display the spirit of devoted service to the advancement of Girls and Women in Sport.
3. An indication of leadership and worthy contribution to the above named areas shall be demonstrated in at least five categories of the following three divisions:

Division I - Leadership and or Offices

- a. A member of the State, District or National Board of Directors of the professional organization.
- b. A member of the District Board or local Unit Board of CAHPERD.
- c. Chairperson of a committee in the NAGWS Board or outstanding and extensive service on a sub-committee of this organization.
- d. Chairperson of a committee in the California GWS or outstanding and extensive service on a sub-committee of this organization.
- e. Chairperson of a local committee or organization.
- f. Outstanding and extensive service with a group affiliated with GWS.

Division II - Writing and Research

- g. Systematic research which has helped advance the cause of GWS.
- h. Articles for newspapers, magazines, handbooks, and other printed media which promote the philosophy and goals of GWS in a positive manner.
- i. Presentation of programs through media other than that listed in (h) which promote the cause of GWS in a positive manner.
- j. Author of books and other materials that help give direction to GWS.

Division III - Speaking, Teaching, Coaching, Performing, Administration

- k. Significant speeches before various types of audiences promoting the best interests of GWS.
- l. Recognized as an outstanding public school teacher and/or coach.
- m. Recognized as an outstanding college, junior college and/or university teacher and/or coach.
- n. Recognized as an outstanding teacher and/or coach of clubs or teams within a community not affiliated with a public or private school or college.
- o. Outstanding success as a performer in a given sports area which has brought recognition and further understanding to the realm of GWS.

The Award will be presented at the GWS Luncheon during the annual CAHPERD conference.
